Our History

Phi Kappa Psi was founded at Jefferson College in Canonsburg, PA in 1852. The Alabama Alpha Chapter was established by esteemed history professor, Dr. John F. Ramsey, in 1964. Since our founding, we have initiated just over 1,000 Brothers.

Academic Support

Your first priority in college is to succeed academically. Phi Psi helps you do that with weekly academic counseling and study hours.

In spring 2017, the chapter gpa was 3.12. 60% of our members made a 3.0 gpa or higher and 32% made a 3.5 gpa or higher. In fall 2017 we had a pledge class gpa of 3.11, with a 3.06 overall chapter gpa.

Personal Development

Being a Phi Psi is more than just social life. We strive to develop each member's full potential. We have a full-time, on-site alumni Chapter Advisor and a House Mother that support the Chapter members. Our national fraternity's health and wellness program, ELEVATE, is unique in the fraternity world and educates members about healthy lifestyle choices. Members also have access to a network of alumni across the nation that assist in professional development and career mentoring.
